Welcome to our after school club based at Shottermill Junior School in Haslemere.

KOOSA Kids run multiple after school, breakfast and holiday clubs across the counties of Hampshire, Berkshire and Surrey. Our aim has always been to provide quality, affordable, active fun childcare during the times that parents need it most; before school, after school and during school holidays. What will my child do each afternoon?

There are a host of fun and stimulating activities for your child to enjoy at their after school club, however we fully understand that at the end of a busy school day children may be tired and just simply want to relax and 'chill out' during their time with us. For this reason, we schedule in **Free Time Zone** straight after the end of the school day (school finish until 4.15pm) and again at the end of the session (5.15pm to 6.00pm).

To ensure we keep your child active and entertained, sandwiched in between **Free Time Zone**, we provide a structured activity chosen by the children (4.15pm to 5.15pm). Games and activities are borrowed from our holiday club themes, **Discovery** and **Endeavour** zones.

Free Time ZONE

Free Time Zone is exactly as it sounds, children choose what they want to do and have the choice of watching a DVD, playing board games, drawing, reading or just simply chilling out.



Each evening children will have the option of taking part in an activity from our

Discovery and **Endeavour** zones. This might include Cool Clay, Building Bonanza, Cricket, Hockey, Golf, Football, Drama activities and much more.

How much will it cost each afternoon?

Please call **0845 094 2322** or visit our website **www.koosakids.co.uk** for up to date costs per child per session. Due to the limited number of places available, there are no discounts available for multiple child families or long term bookings.

How do i book my child?

Call **0845 094 2322** or visit **www.koosakids.co.uk** to register your child. If you have a long term childcare requirement and are aware you will need certain days of the week on an ongoing basis, please call us as soon as possible to inform us of the permanent days you require. If your requirements are more changeable, subject to availability, you can book single or multiple sessions up to 6pm the evening before you require the childcare.

Who will look after my child?

The club is managed by an experienced and qualified member of the KOOSA Kids team.

All KOOSA Kids staff are cleared with the criminal records bureau and demonstrate both the qualifications and experience necessary to work in such a setting. For added assurance there is always a paediatric first aid qualified team member present at all times.

Do i need to provide drinks and snacks for my child?

KOOSA Kids will provide your child on arrival at the club with a snack. A selection of healthy and nutritious food will be made available, including toast and a variety of fruit. Drinking water will always be available. The above service is optional, and if you would prefer to pack your own snacks, KOOSA Kids recommend a second lunchbox and to consider healthy foods that will not require refrigeration, for example, fruit, hard cheese, bread, crackers and raisins and to pack frozen ice gel or fruit juice.
