Dear Parents,

Welcome back to Shottermill and Year 5, where we have many exciting activities planned for the term ahead! The following newsletter is aimed at providing some useful reminders for how you can support your child's learning and development whilst they are in Year 5.

Being well prepared for school:

Children are welcome to bring a small, named pencil case to school with the following items: a whiteboard pen, a black pen, a pencil, a long ruler (non-bendy) some colouring pencils and a glue stick. Children should also remember to bring their PE kit, homework, reading book and musical instruments if they currently receive tuition in school.

PE currently takes place on a Tuesday with Mrs Butchart for 5B and a Wednesday for 5M. Class PE is taught on a Thursday for both classes. As with all personal belongings, children's PE kits should be clearly labelled and kept in a named bag.

Homework:

The homework diary and any related sheets are available on the website each week. In addition to the homework set in the table below, children are expected to read to an adult for 10-15 minutes each night, which should be recorded in their Reading Diary. We would also welcome any further adult volunteers to hear children read in school. Please contact the office if you are able to help.
