


How did Britain change between 1750 and 1900?

Use these two images/sources to highlight the key similarities and differences - circle differences and discuss with someone.




The Industrial Revolution was the growth of industry in Britain from 1750 till the late 1800s.

Britain began to make money from products which it <u>made</u>, not products which it grew.

How did 1750 compare to 1900?

Factor	1750	1900
Population	7 million	37 million
People living in towns	13%	87%
Life Expectancy	Men 31 Women 33	Men 45 Women 48


