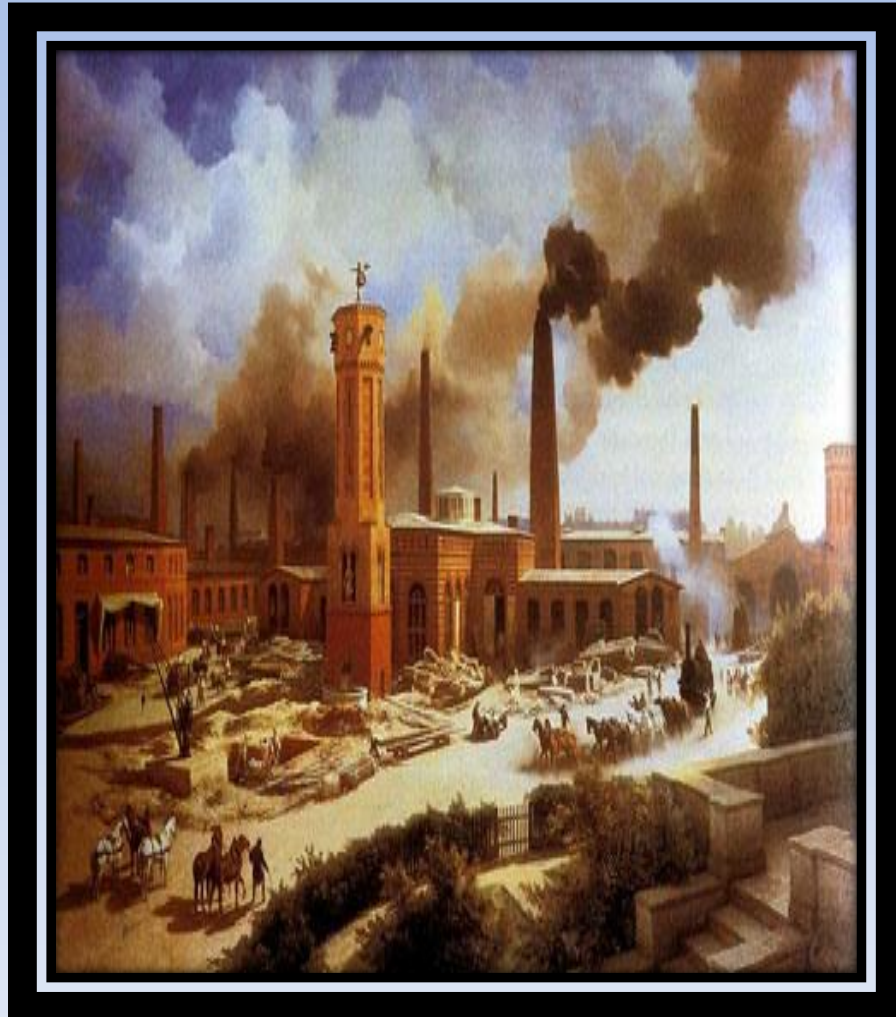


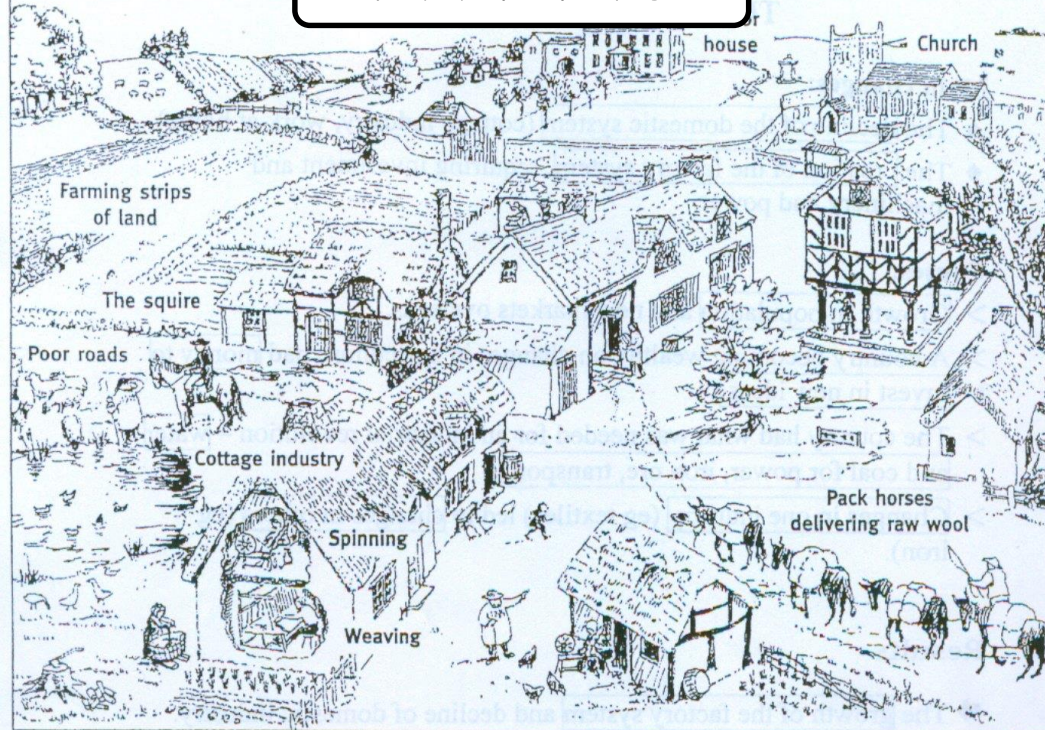

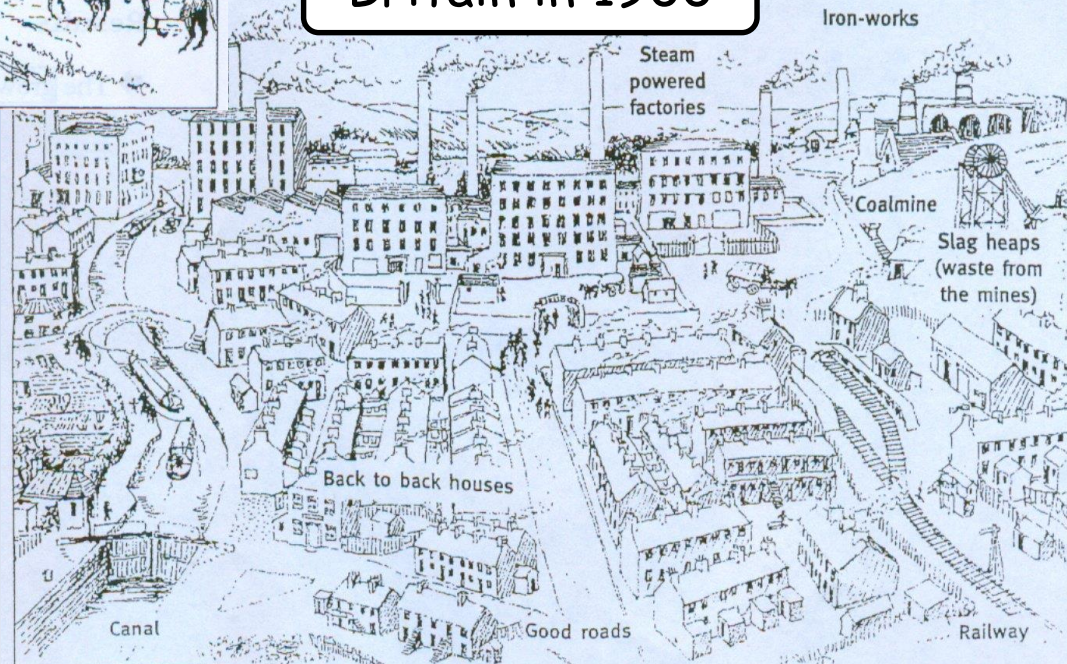

Britain began to make money from products which it made, not products which it grew.

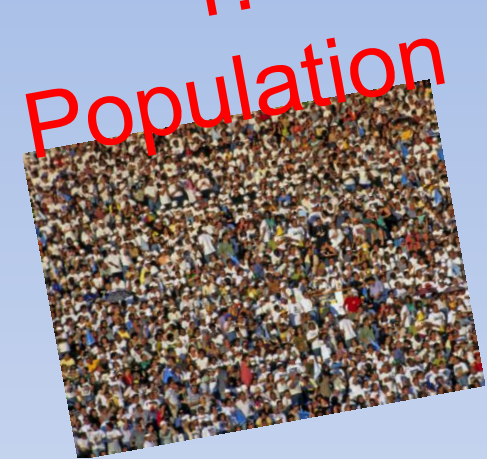
# How did 1750 compare to 1900?
