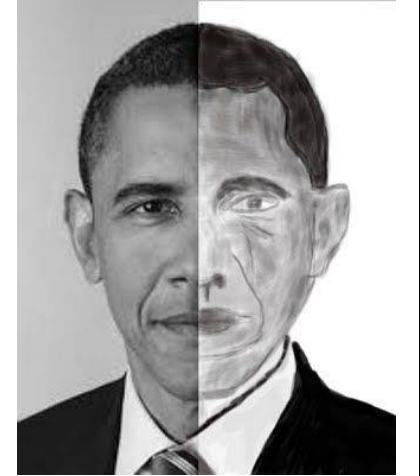


### Half Photo, Half Face Sketch
