

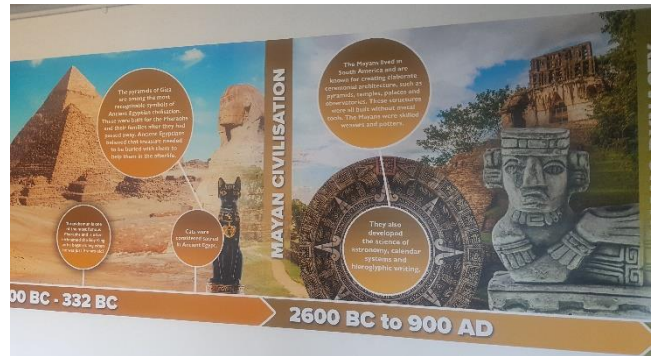


### TIMELINE WALL MURAL

## TACKLING SEXUAL HARRASSMENT AND SEXUAL VIOLENCE

Recently, we have come to learn more about the prevalence of sexual harassment between young people and the harmful impacts that this may have in the long-term on their wellbeing and ability to form healthy relationships. Many parents of pupils in the primary age range may not realise that from time to time, young people will use language or behaviours which could fall into the category of sexual harassment. This problem is often dismissed as affecting only girls or pupils in secondary schools. Although these kinds of behaviours are rare, we must all accept our part in teaching our children how to treat each other with respect and in particular, how to use online technologies safely and responsibly.

We feel that it would be helpful to share with you the attached parent information leaflets to help guide conversations and help protect children from experiencing this form of abuse in the future. In school we will be using our PSHE and Relationships & Sex Education lessons to help subtly address this issue, as children grow and develop year on year.

*Penalty Notices - Just to remind parents/carers that if you take your child out of school without authority, you will be liable to receive a penalty notice. Currently the amount payable under a penalty notice is £60.00 per parent/carer per child if paid within 21 days. Thereafter the amount increases to £120.00 if paid between 21 and 28 days. If the penalty notice remains unpaid after 28 days, the Local Authority will consider a prosecution in the Magistrates Court. Please note that penalty notices are issued per parent/carer per child so a family of two parents and two children will receive four penalty notices.
