### CHARITY BIKE RIDE

Last year Tom Pearse (who has a daughter in Year 6) decided to ride from Haslemere to Ilfracombe off road to raise money for Wills in Year 6. This year Tom is making the challenge even harder and has managed to convince other fellow cyclists that it's a good idea to ride over 210 miles off road in 4 days with him!

Eleven year old Wills has **Duchenne Muscular Dystrophy** which is a progressive muscle wasting disease which affects his whole body and is incurable, which is why every day counts and his family needs to make happy memories. DMD affects mainly boys who sadly begin to lose their ability to walk between the ages of 9 – 12. Unfortunately, in the first lockdown at only 10, Wills lost his ability to walk. He now needs a downstairs bedroom and bathroom and this challenge will raise funds to help Will's family make these much needed changes to their home.

So on Monday 30<sup>th</sup> May the riders will begin their worthwhile challenge, by riding over 210 miles and climbing more than 12,800 feet and doing as much as possible off road. The route will take then from Haslemere, Surrey to Ilfracombe, North Devon via Ringwood, Ilminster and Porlock in ONLY four days. Currently the amount payable under a penalty notice is £60.00 per parent/carer per child if paid within 21 days. Thereafter the amount increases to £120.00 if paid between 21 and 28 days. If the penalty notice remains unpaid after 28 days, the Local Authority will consider a prosecution in the Magistrates Court. Please note that penalty notices are issued per parent/carer per child so a family of two parents and two children will receive four penalty notices.
