Dear Parents,

Welcome back to Shottermill and Year 5, where we have many exciting activities planned for the term ahead! The following newsletter is aimed at providing some useful reminders for how you can support your child's learning and development whilst they are in Year 5.

Being well prepared for school:

Children are welcome to bring a small, named pencil case to school with the following items: a whiteboard pen, a black pen, a blue pen, a pencil, a long ruler (non-bendy) some colouring pencils, felt tips, scissors and a glue stick (this is essential!). Children should also remember to wear their P.E. kit to school on their P.E. days (Tuesdays and Wednesdays for 5RB and Mondays and Tuesdays for 5W).

Homework:

The homework diary and any related sheets are available on the Google Classroom each week and should be returned this way if possible. In addition to the homework set in the table below, children are expected to read to an adult for 10-15 minutes each night, which should be recorded in their Reading Diary.

There will be a spelling test every Friday using spellings set for the children on Monday of that week. The children will be set spellings to learn that are appropriate to their current spelling levels. The children have been told which spelling group they are in (*, ** or ***) and should learn these spellings as a minimum. They are also welcome to learn and be tested on the spellings from ** and *** lists if they wish.
