## Scheme of work to be taught:

## Year 3

Children will be introduced to the concept of learning a new language and why this is important.
Children will begin to learn basic words and phrases in isolation and practise these through the four skills: listening, speaking, reading and writing.
Begin to understand gender forms in French language.

Autumn - All About Me
Classroom instructions (levez-vous, ouvrez les cahiers, repetez)
Listening and responding to simple rhymes and songs (morning routine song etc.)
Learning how to introduce yourself, asking and answering basic questions about me (je m'appelle..., j'ai sept ans, comment vas tu?, etc)
Beginning to write basic words and phrases in French
Learning and counting to 12 in French
Describing what is in your classroom and in your pencil case and phrases (prends un crayon)

Spring - Birthdays \& Family

## Year 5

Children will continue to revisit and extend learning from Year 4 using the four skills. Children will refine their skills in using a bilingual dictionary.
Further develop confidence in using gender forms in French language.

## Autumn - Sports

Creating longer spoken and written sentences including a conjunction (et, mais, parce que)
Learning vocabulary for different sports
Expressing opinions about sports (J'aime, je deteste, je n'aime pas, j'adore)
Writing about seasonal sports
Writing a sporting diary
Explore 'All Saints Day’ or Christmas 'Noel' festivities
Spring - Visiting the town
Learning vocabulary for places and features around the town (un parc, un magasin) Describing features of a town (il y a un petit magasin, il n'y a pas un cinema) Giving directions within a town (toute droite, a gauche, a droite)

Be introduced to numbers up to 31 in French
Learning the days of the week and months of the year in French
Learning how to write the date and rules for lack of capitalisation
Be able to ask and answer about birthdays (quelle la date de ton anniversaire? Mon anniversaire est ....)
Describing members of my family and review masculine / feminine

Summer - Fairy Tales and Nursery Rhymes
Learning vocabulary for basic colours in French
Learn to tell the time (il est six heures, il est midi, il est minuit)
Play 'What's the time Mr Wolf?'
Listen to and appreciate familiar Fairy Tales in French, including listening, responding, singing and role play.
Sequence familiar stories matching French phrases and pictures.

## Year 4

Children will continue to revisit and extend learning from Year 3 using the four skills.
Children will be introduced to using a bilingual dictionary.
Continue to develop knowledge of gender forms in French language.

Autumn - Travel (links to Mountains topic in Year 4)
Learning vocabulary for different types of transport
Use of nouns and verbs in speech and writing (je vais en Espagne)
Knowledge of European and Francophone countries and where these are located
Identifying mountain ranges such as the Alps and Pyrenees
Undertake research for a French speaking country to create a fact file using words from memory

Spring - Animals
Consolidate and know confidently numbers up to 31
Learning vocabulary for different pets, farm animals and wild animals
Asking and answering questions about pets (j'ai un chien, il a / elle a un chat)
Revisit colours and introduce size when describing animals using simple adjectives (le mouton est blanc)

## Summer - Weather

Learning vocabulary for different types of weather (il pleut, il neige)
Adjectives for describing weather (chaud, froid)
Listening to and presenting a weather forecast
Creating a class weather poem and present this for orally for performance
Writing own weather poems

Develop understanding of numbers up to 69 and make lines to distances travelled.
Explore the festival of Mardi Gras or compare how Easter is celebrated in France.

## Summer - Lunchtime

Learning the vocabulary for a selection of lunchtime foods and drinks, fruits and vegetables
Comparing a contrasting French and English lunchtime culture
Designing an English lunchbox and planning French school lunch menu
Expressing opinions on foods and drinks
Expressing whether foods are healthy or not
Extend to French reading comprehension activity with recipes, translating into English the steps and ingredients required.

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Children will continue to revisit and extend learning from Year 5 using the four skills.
Children will increase their confidence in using a bilingual dictionary with independence. Secure understand in gender forms in French language.

Autumn - French Café Life
Conjugating basic verbs (je mange, je bois, il / elle mange, il / elle boit)
Learning the vocabulary for café foods, drinks
Comparing and contrasting French and English cafés
Understanding French currency
Designing own café menus using words and phrases from memory
Learning how to order food in French and roleplaying ordering food in a café
Taking part in French food tasting
Explore 'All Saints Day' or Christmas 'Noel' festivities

Spring - Clothes Shopping
Identifying gender and apply rules of adjectival agreement (un pantalon bleu, une jupe blanche)
Learning vocabulary for items of clothing and accessories
Describing clothing
Giving opinions and reasons on clothing
Describing what others are wearing using different parts of the verb
Roleplaying how to buy clothing in a shop
Explore the festival of Mardi Gras or compare how Easter is celebrated in France.

## Learning numbers up to 100

Learning to tell the time (et demie, et quart, moins le quart)
Learning vocabulary for a range of school subjects and using timetables
Comparing and contrasting French and English schools
Learning vocabulary for different places around school using prepositions (a cote de..)

## Giving opinions and reasons about school subject
