Dear Parents,

Welcome back to the Spring Term of 2024, where we have many exciting things planned for the weeks ahead! The following newsletter is aimed at providing some useful reminders for how you can support your child's learning and development whilst they are in Year 4.

Being well prepared for school:

Children are welcome to bring a small, named pencil case to school with the following items: a black pen, a pencil, a long ruler (non-bendy) some colouring pencils and a glue stick. Children should also remember to bring their coat, water bottle, school reading book, reading record and musical instruments, if they currently receive tuition in school.

Children should come to school in their PE kit on the days that they have PE, which currently takes place as follows:

4H – Wednesday and Friday

4ZC – Monday and Wednesday

As with all personal belongings, children's PE kits should be clearly labelled.

Homework:

The homework diary and any related sheets are available on Google Classroom each week. In addition to the homework set in the table below, children are expected to read to an adult for 10 – 15 minutes each night, which should be recorded in their Reading Diary. The children also need to learn their times tables for rapid recall and the TT Rockstars homework should be completed regularly.
