Dear Parents,

Welcome back to the Spring Term of 2024. The following newsletter is aimed at providing some useful reminders for how you can support your child's learning and development whilst they are in Year 6.

Details of the key areas studied this term, in each of the National Curriculum subjects, can be found by downloading the **Spring Term Curriculum Overview**, which is available on the Curriculum and Class Information pages of the school website.

Being well prepared for school: Children are welcome to bring a small, named pencil case to school with the following items: a black pen, a blue pen, a pencil, a long ruler (non-bendy), scissors, whiteboard pen, sharpener, some colouring pencils and a glue stick. Children should also remember to bring their PE kit, reading book and musical instruments if they currently receive tuition in school.

P.E. currently takes place on Mondays and Wednesdays for 6H and Mondays and Tuesdays for 6W. On P.E. days, children need to wear their P.E. kit to school. As with all personal belongings, children's P.E. kits should be clearly labelled. We would like parents to write a letter if there is a medical reason why their child is unable to participate in P.E.

Homework schedule: The homework diary and any related sheets are available on Google Classroom each week. In addition to the homework set in the table below, children are expected to read to an adult for 15 minutes each night, which should be recorded in their reading diary.
