Dear Parents,

Welcome back to the Summer Term of 2024, where we have many exciting things planned for the weeks ahead, including swimming as the weather improves! Being well prepared for school:

Children need to continue to restock their pencil cases with the following items: a whiteboard pen, a pencil, a long ruler (non-bendy), some colouring pencils and a glue stick. Each day children should bring their reading book and reading diary.

Children should also remember to come to school in their correct PE kit, with hair tied back and earrings removed. PE currently takes place on a Tuesday and Thursday for both. It is important that children remember their water bottles and sun protection everyday, this includes a SJS cap to be worn at outside playtimes and PE.

Homework:

The homework diary and any related sheets are available on the Google Classroom each week. The paper copies of the homework diary and spelling homework will be sent on Mondays. In addition to the homework set, children are expected to read to an adult for 10 minutes each night. This should be recorded in their Reading Diary by parents and summarised by the children as we check daily.
