How has your school's spending improved PE attainment?

Last year 81.6% of pupils achieved the Expected Standard or Greater Depth Standard, according to our Specialist PE Teacher Assessments for the Summer Terms 2023. This has increased to 92.9% of children achieving the Expected Standard or Greater Depth Standard in the Summer Term of 2024.

How has your school's spending increased school sport participation?

The Sports Premium has been used to pay for subscriptions to sports partnerships (e.g. Bohunt Partnership) which has provided us with a number of sporting fixtures to attend throughout the year, in particular non-competitive 'just for fun' activities.

How has your school's spending increased pupil participation in extra-curricular activities?

Sports Premium pays for our PE Specialist Teacher who has led a number of after school / lunchtime clubs for children to attend. It has also helped to ensure we have the necessary high quality equipment to use at these sessions (e.g. older children have been provided with individual gum shields for Hockey)

How has your school's spending increased staff training and continued professional development (CPD)?

Class Teacher subject knowledge has been raised through staff meeting CPD sessions which provide updates on good practice. Teachers also benefit from watching a specialist teacher lead their PE lessons throughout the year.

How has your school's spending increased staff participation in extra-curricular activities and school sports competitions?

We have attended Confederation Sports this year as well as a number of Bohunt Sports Partnership fixtures. As a consequence, staff have had a lot more involvement in competitive events and extra-curricular activities.

How has your school's spending improved swimming attainment?

Last year 69% of Yr 6 pupils could use a range of strokes effectively in swimming. This has risen this year to 79% this year.

How has your school's spending improved water safety awareness?

Last year, 72% of pupils could perform safe self-rescue in the swimming pool. This has risen to 79% this year.

The sports premium will continue to secure the provision of a Specialist PE Teacher at our school, as well as funding for extra-curricular sports and subscriptions to local partnerships, which provide fixtures for our pupils to be involved with.
