Dear Parents and Guardians,

This letter outlines the clubs available for the Spring Term 2025. If your child would like to attend any of the **teacher-led clubs**, you will need to book your child's place on **Scopay**. The Clubs will be available to book on Scopay from **approximately 11:00am on Monday 6th January 2025**. The clubs do take a little time to load on to Scopay, so please bear with us if the club you would like to book isn't immediately visible and please avoid ringing the school office regarding clubs until all the clubs have loaded.

To book and pay:

1. Please log into your child's Scopay account as normal.
2. Go to 'Optional Trips and Events'.
3. Select the club you wish to sign up.
4. Follow the instructions to make payment – your child will then be signed up to the club.

Where there is a limited number of children allowed in the club (as shown on the club list overleaf) and the maximum number has been reached, the club will no longer be available to book **and will disappear from Scopay**.

Charging for teacher-led clubs:

The charge from the Spring Term 2025 for teacher-led clubs will be **£16.00 per club**. Payment **must be made** at the time of booking in order to secure a place at the club. If your child is in receipt of Free School Meals and you feel that you cannot meet this cost, please contact the School Office to discuss this.

Please ensure that you have booked and paid for clubs on Scopay by **10.30am on Friday 10th January 2025**.

Teacher-led clubs will **start the week commencing 13th January** and will continue **until Week ending 28th March 2025**

We have a policy of not cancelling clubs due to staff absence or poor weather. In these circumstances, alternative arrangements will be made within school, however, some clubs **will not run** on the week of **parent consultation evenings (date to be advised) and on Thursday 23rd January 2025 – Young Voices day**. We will always give you as much notice as possible should any further clubs need to be cancelled.



If children attend a lunchtime club, they will need to eat their lunch first.

We also expect children to commit to attending their chosen club each week. If your child is not able to attend any **teacher-led clubs (school-run)**, parents must inform the school of this in good time, so that we may ensure the safety of all children at the end of the school day.
