



MESSAGE FROM THE HEADTEACHER

HOT WEATHER

Following the heatwave this week, and the likelihood that the weather will remain warm for the foreseeable it is important that everyone takes extra care to stay safe and healthy. While sunny days provide great opportunities for outdoor activities, excessive heat can lead to dehydration, sunburn, and heat-related illnesses.

We ask that pupils remember to bring a refillable water bottle to school each day and to drink water regularly. Staff will remind children to stay hydrated throughout the day and water bottles can be refilled when needed. Pupils should wear sun hats and apply sunscreen before coming to school. We also recommend that children bring a named bottle of sunscreen for children to apply independently – particularly after swimming.

Please do not send your child in with jumpers and hoodies during particularly hot days! Year 6 have been reminded to remove their hoodies on several occasions this week and it would be helpful if these could be kept safe at home.

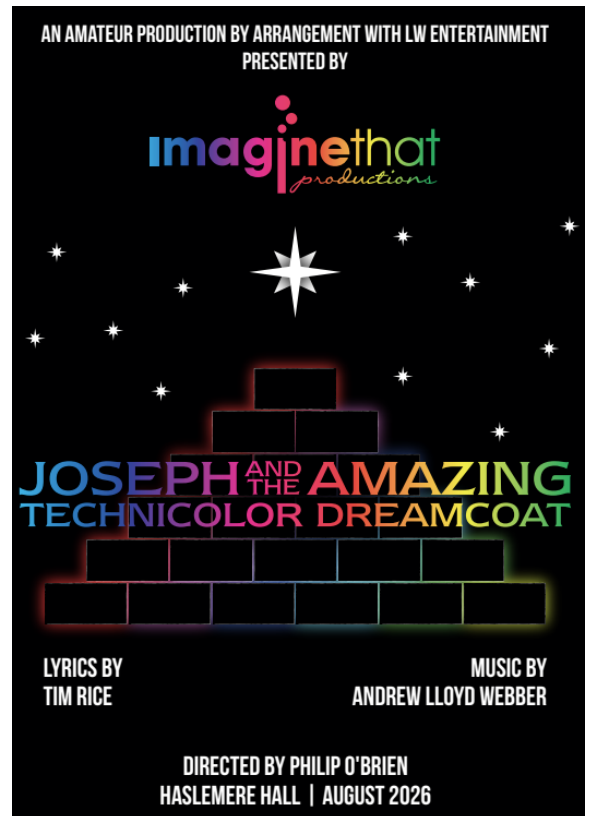

Penalty Notices - Just to remind parents/carers that if you take your child out of school without authority, you will be liable to receive a penalty notice. Currently the amount payable is £80.00 per parent/carer per child if paid within 21 days. Thereafter the amount increases to £160.00 if paid between 21 and 28 days. Failure to pay the Penalty Notice will result in Surrey County Council considering legal proceedings against you in the Magistrates Court. Please note that penalty notices are issued per parent/carer per child so a family of two parents and two children will receive four penalty notices. Please note if you have received a penalty notice fine since 19th August 2024 the second penalty notice will be a flat fee of £160.00 – there is no reduction in fee regardless of how quickly payment is received. If you incur two penalty notices within three years you will NOT receive a third penalty notice – Surrey County Council will have no option but to consider a prosecution, per parent/carer per child, in the Magistrates Court under s 444 Education Act 1996.
